- 1 International applicants with nationality outside of Greater China;
- 2 Applying to one of our 8 full-time (1 Year) taught postgraduate programmes;
- 3 Meeting the programme admission requirements;
- 4 Demonstrating competitive academic performance and/or professional experience;
- 5 Willingness to serve the School in its internationalisation and student-related projects during the study period.

The admission committee of each programme will evaluate each application thoroughly based on all the information submitted in the online application as well as the applicant's interview and/or written test performance. Please note that IPS is a competitive scholarship for highly-qualified international students. The programme office may offer a scholarship other than IPS, or even no scholarship, to an admitted international student.
